- Scarecrows are to be installed on Thursday or Friday (September 19 or 20) during museum business hours (10:00 am to 4:00 pm).
 - Please check in at the museum store entrance where you will then be directed to the set-up area by museum staff. There is no admission charge to install your scarecrow!
 - Scarecrows must be in good taste, handmade by the entrant, and constructed to withstand the weather.
- Remick Country Doctor Museum & Farm reserves the right to remove any entry it deems inappropriate or in disrepair.
 - The winning entry will be determined by a panel of judges prior to the opening of Harvest Festival.
 - Entries must remain on display during the entire Harvest Festival event on Saturday, September 21st.
 - Remick Country Doctor Museum & Farm is not responsible for any loss or damage to entries at any time before, during or after the event.
 - Entrants will be allowed to remove their scarecrow beginning at 3:00 pm at the end of Harvest Festival, or during business hours, September 23 through September 25.
 - Unclaimed entries remaining onsite beginning on September 26 will become property of Remick Country Doctor Museum & Farm.
